#### Via I-80 Eastbound:

- Follow Interstate 80 eastbound towards Joliet, to the Chicago St./Route 53 northbound exit (#132B.)
- Follow Chicago St. toward downtown Joliet. You will pass the Adult Detention Facility on your left and approach a viaduct. Stay to the right on the road and go under the viaduct.
- Turn right after you go under the viaduct and follow the curve around passing Union Train Station on your right. After the curve you will be on Scott St.
- Follow Scott St. to Cass St. (stop light.)
- Go straight through the light and watch for Benton St.
- Just past Benton St. is the Will County Office building. Turn left into the parking lot (immediately after the loading dock.)
- Entering the building:
  - 1. If arriving during business hours (Mon-Fri, 8:30 am-4:30 pm); enter through the main doors; take the elevator to the basement; exit the elevator to the right; EMA office is the first door on the left; ring buzzer.
  - 2. If arriving at times other than business hours, the main doors will be locked. Proceed to the door to the right of the main doors; ring buzzer (signs will be posted to prompt you.)

#### Via I-80 Westbound:

- Follow Interstate 80 westbound towards Joliet, to the Chicago St./Route 53 exit (#132.)
- At bottom of exit ramp, turn left (heading north.)
- Follow Chicago St. toward downtown Joliet. You will pass the Adult Detention Facility on your left and approach a viaduct. Stay to the right on the road and go under the viaduct.
- Turn right after you go under the viaduct and follow the curve around passing Union Train Station on your right. After the curve you will be on Scott St.
- Follow Scott St. to Cass St. (stop light.)
- Go straight through the light and watch for Benton St.
- Just past Benton St. is the Will County Office building. Turn left into the parking lot (immediately after the loading dock.)
- Entering the building:

- 1. If arriving during business hours (Mon-Fri, 8:30 am-4:30 pm); enter through the main doors; take the elevator to the basement; exit the elevator to the right; EMA office is the first door on the left; ring buzzer.

- Turn right after you go under the viaduct and follow the curve around passing Union Train Station on your right. After the curve you will be on Scott St.
- Follow Scott St. to Cass St. (stop light.)
- Go straight through the light and watch for Benton St.
- Just past Benton St. is the Will County Office building. Turn left into the parking lot (immediately after the loading dock.)
- Entering the building:
  - 1. If arriving during business hours (Mon-Fri, 8:30 am-4:30 pm); enter through the main doors; take the elevator to the basement; exit the elevator to the right; EMA office is the first door on the left; ring buzzer.

- Follow Route 53 south into Joliet (passing Lewis University and Stateville Correctional Center) continuing to Ruby Street (drawbridge will be on your left.)
- Turn left onto Ruby Street, go over the drawbridge, and follow the curve to the right, which then becomes Chicago St.
- Continue south on Chicago Street approximately four blocks to Jackson Street (stop light.)
- Continue past Jackson Street. Will County Office Building will be immediately on your left.
- Entering the building:
  - 1. If arriving during business hours (Mon-Fri, 8:30 am-4:30 pm); enter through the main doors; take the elevator to the basement; exit the elevator to the right; EMA office is the first door on the left; ring buzzer.
  - 2. If arriving at times other than business hours, the main doors will be locked. Proceed to the door to the right of the main doors; ring buzzer (signs will be posted to prompt you.)
