SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2023 Amended Allocations for FEMA's Shelter and Services Program Reserve Funding

Today, the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), announced the availability of the final reserve funding for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Shelter and Services Program (SSP).

The FY 2023 SSP makes federal funds available to enable non-federal entities to offset allowable costs incurred for services associated with noncitizen migrants recently released from DHS in their communities. The amended allocations released today represent the final reserved portion of the \$363.8 million in available FY 2023 federal assistance and may be found online at <http://www.fema.gov/grants>. The amount available during this final reserve allocation of funding is \$12,219,525.

This reserve funding was allocated based on operational considerations including, but not limited to

- an eligible applicant's location at the Southwest Border (California, Arizona, New Mexico, Texas);
- data from U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) on migrant encounters, releases, and demographics; and
- recent reports, trends, policies, and intelligence on migrants from federal sources involved in day-to-day operations in the Southwest Border.
 - These operation considerations have the following order of priority:
 1. the applicant's location at the Southwest Border and CBP data on noncitizen migrant encounters, releases, and demographics;
 2. recent reports, projection estimates, and trends from federal sources; and policies and intelligence on migrants from federal sources involved in day-to-day operations at the Southwest Border.
