- Contractors and home repair contracts.
- Insurance claims and policy holder rights.
- FEMA decisions and the right to appeal (see page 2 for more information on appeals).
- Landlords and tenant rights.
- Mortgages and threats of foreclosure.
- Proving home ownership.
- Wills and powers of attorney.
- Replacing or redoing legal documents lost or damaged.
- Possible scams and identity theft.

When You Call

- You will hear a generic prompt to leave a message.
- Leave your name and phone number, at minimum.
- In addition to your contact information...
 - State the storm-related legal problem you need help solving.
 - State the city and county of your storm-damaged property.

The volunteer attorneys are not FEMA employees. Any information you share with these attorneys is kept confidential. They do not share information with FEMA.
