One Week Left for Floridians to Apply for FEMA Assistance After Hurricanes Milton and Helene

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. -- Floridians who sustained loss from Hurricanes <u>Milton</u> or <u>Helene</u> have one week remaining to apply for federal assistance. The deadline is Jan. 7, 2025.

If you applied for FEMA assistance after Hurricane Helene and have additional damage from Hurricane Milton, you will need to apply separately for Milton and provide the dates of your most recent damage.

Homeowners and renters are encouraged to apply online at <u>DisasterAssistance.gov</u> or by using the <u>FEMA App</u>. You may also apply by phone at **800-621-3362.** Lines are open every day and help is available in most languages. If you use a relay service, captioned telephone or other service, give FEMA your number for that service.
