

Okaloosa County Recovery at a Glance

Release Date: Dec 17, 2020

Since the federal disaster declaration for Hurricane Sally, Okaloosa County residents have received approximately

\$10.7 million in total federal funds.

Individual Assistance (as of Dec. 17):

- **204** homeowners and renters have been approved for more than **\$1 million** in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program. This includes:
 - More than **\$919,000** in Housing Assistance grants for housing repair costs, home replacement and rental payments.
 - More than **\$146,000** in Other Needs Assistance grants to replace essential household items and for other critical disaster-related costs.
- **147** homeowners and renters were approved for rental assistance.
- **159** survivors have not provided FEMA with the necessary information from their insurance settlements to complete their disaster assistance application.

National Flood Insurance Program (as of Dec. 13):

- **320** flood insurance claims have been filed. An estimated **\$7.6 million** has been paid in claims.

U.S. Small Business Administration (as of Dec. 13):

- More than **\$2.1 million** has been approved in low-interest disaster loans for **56** homeowners, renters and businesses.

Public Assistance (as of Dec. 7):

- Okaloosa County was approved for assistance to local governments and private nonprofits for emergency protective measures on Sept. 23, and for debris removal as well as the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged public facilities on Oct. 13.



- Eight requests for Public Assistance have been received and approved.
