Escambia County Recovery at a Glance

Since the federal disaster declaration for Hurricane Sally, Escambia County residents have received approximately **\$146 million** in total federal funds.

Individual Assistance (as of Dec. 7):

- 6,102 homeowners and renters have been approved for more than \$24.4 million in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program. This includes:
 - More than \$18.5 million in Housing Assistance grants for housing repair costs, home replacement and rental payments.
 - More than \$5.9 million in Other Needs Assistance grants to replace essential household items and for other critical disaster-related costs.
- **4,010** homeowners and renters were approved for rental assistance.
- **4,433** survivors have not provided FEMA with the necessary information from their insurance settlements to complete their disaster assistance application.

National Flood Insurance Program (as of Dec. 8):

■ 2,416 flood insurance claims have been filed. An estimated \$73.5 million has been paid in claims.

U.S. Small Business Administration (as of Dec. 6):

• More than \$48.1 million has been approved in low-interest disaster loans for 1,290 homeowners, renters and businesses.

Public Assistance (as of Dec. 7):

- Escambia County was approved for assistance to local governments and private nonprofits for debris removal, emergency protective measures and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged public facilities on Sept. 23.
- 26 requests for Public Assistance have been received and 23 have been approved.
