

FEMA Disaster Recovery Center now open in Ciales

SAN JUAN, Puerto Rico – The government of Puerto Rico and FEMA opened a Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) in Ciales on Sunday, Dec. 17.

DRCs serve homeowners, renters and business owners who sustained damage as a result of Hurricane Maria. Specialists from the government of Puerto Rico and municipalities, FEMA, the U.S. Small Business Administration, nongovernmental organizations and the local community will be on hand to help survivors register for assistance, answer questions and provide information on the types of assistance available to survivors. Services are provided in English and Spanish.

The **Ciales DRC** is open **7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Saturdays**

Lines are open **7 a.m. to 11 p.m.** daily.

Registering with FEMA is the first step toward qualifying for disaster assistance which may include grants to help homeowners and renters pay for temporary housing, essential home repairs, personal property replacements and disaster-related needs not covered by insurance.
