- Visiting any of the recovery centers that remain open. To find center locations and current hours, download the <u>FEMA mobile app</u>, the <u>ReadyNC app</u>, or visit <u>FEMA.gov/DRC</u>. Center hours and operations are adjusted based on visitor demand. Starting Dec. 3 most centers will be open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and from 9 a.m.to 1 p.m., Saturday until further notice. All are closed Sundays.
