

# Escambia County Recovery at a Glance

Since the federal disaster declaration for Hurricane Sally, Escambia County residents have received approximately **\$146 million** in total federal funds.

## Individual Assistance (as of Dec. 7):

- **6,102** homeowners and renters have been approved for more than **\$24.4 million** in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program. This includes:
  - More than **\$18.5 million** in Housing Assistance grants for housing repair costs, home replacement and rental payments.
  - More than **\$5.9 million** in Other Needs Assistance grants to replace essential household items and for other critical disaster-related costs.
- **4,010** homeowners and renters were approved for rental assistance.
- **4,433** survivors have not provided FEMA with the necessary information from their insurance settlements to complete their disaster assistance application.

## National Flood Insurance Program (as of Dec. 8):

- **2,416** flood insurance claims have been filed. An estimated **\$73.5 million** has been paid in claims.

## U.S. Small Business Administration (as of Dec. 6):

- More than **\$48.1 million** has been approved in low-interest disaster loans for **1,290** homeowners, renters and businesses.

## Public Assistance (as of Dec. 7):

- Escambia County was approved for assistance to local governments and private nonprofits for debris removal, emergency protective measures and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged public facilities on Sept. 23.
- 26 requests for Public Assistance have been received and 23 have been approved.
