Lee County Recovery at a Glance

Since the federal disaster declaration for Hurricane Ian, Lee County residents have received more than **\$997.1** million in federal funds as of Dec. 12, 2022:

- **\$337.9 million** in FEMA grants to homeowners and renters.
- \$659.2 million in U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) low-interest disaster loans approved for homeowners, renters and businesses.

Individual Assistance in Lee County:

- 191,720 homeowners and renters have been approved for \$337,917,362 in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program. This includes:
 - \$247,900,424 in Housing Assistance grants for home repair, home replacement, and/or rental assistance.
 - \$90,016,938 in Other Needs Assistance grants to replace essential household items and for other critical disaster-related expenses.
- 18,686 homeowners and renters have been approved for rental assistance.
- Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA) visited 117,900 households in Lee County.

U.S. Small Business Administration:

- SBA has approved \$659,280,677 in low-interest disaster loans to 7.849 applicants in Lee County.
