FEMA Corps is a full-time program for young adults to travel the country in teams and help people before, during and after disasters.

What is FEMA Corps?

FEMA Corps is a partnership between FEMA and the [AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps program](#). FEMA Corps is a unique, team-based service program that gives young adults the opportunity to serve communities impacted by disasters while gaining valuable federal work and emergency management experience.

The FEMA Corps program provides hands-on work experience that often aligns with the experience required for some FEMA positions. As part of the FEMA Corps program, members are invited to participate in specialized hiring events to engage with the agency and interview for positions following successful completion of the program.

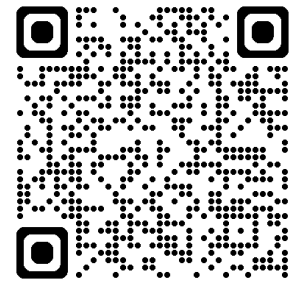


FEMA Corps participants live, work and travel the country in teams, serving the nation for 10 months. Team leaders and members receive a meal allowance, student loan forbearance, lodging, medical benefits, structured professional development and a living stipend for personal expenses. Upon successful completion of FEMA Corps, members will earn the [Segal AmeriCorps Education Award](#), and be eligible for potential job opportunities.

Benefits and Eligibility

- To serve as a corps member, you must be between 18-26 years old. There is no upper age-limit for team leaders.
- You must be U.S. citizen or a lawful permanent resident.
- You must be available for service for 10-12 consecutive months.
