SUBJECT:	Supplemental Funding Available for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Non-Profit Security Grant Program (NSGP) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)		

#### I. Purpose

The purpose of this Information Bulletin (IB) is to announce that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Grant Programs Directorate (GPD) is making additional funds available under the FY 2024 NSGP NOFO.

#### **II.** Applicability

This IB is applicable to all states and urban areas as eligible applicants and recipients under the FY 2024 NSGP.

#### III. Guidance

The original FY 2024 NSGP NOFO made available \$274,500,000 in funding as provided under the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Appropriations Act, 2024 (P.L. 118-47). The amended NOFO makes available an additional \$160,000,000 in supplemental funding for the FY 2024 NSGP as provided under the National Security Supplemental (Israel Security Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2024 (P.L. 118-50)). In total, the FY 2024 NSGP provides \$434,500,000 in funding support for facility hardening and other physical security enhancements and activities to nonprofit organizations that are at high risk of a terrorist or other extremist attack. The supplemental funding is being equally split between the NSGP-Urban Area (UA) and NSGP-State (S) programs. The supplemental funds are being added to the existing FY 2024 NSGP NOFO because FEMA GPD expects application funding requests will exceed the original funding total. Separate applications are not required to receive supplemental funds. The tables below specify high-risk urban areas and eligible applicants under NSGP-UA and NSGP-S, target allocations for eligible states under NSGP-S. The NSGP-S Target Allocations table below has been amended to include supplemental funding for the FY 2024 NSGP as provided under the National Security Supplemental (Israel Security Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2024):
