Dear Tribal Leader:

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) remains committed to our responsibility under Executive Order 13175, *Consultation and Coordination with Indian Tribal Governments*, reaffirmed by President Biden's <u>January 26, 2021</u>, "Memorandum on Tribal Consultation and Strengthening Nation-to-Nation Relationships," and reflected in <u>FEMA's Tribal Consultation Policy</u>, to engage in meaningful consultation and collaboration with tribal officials. FEMA is also committed to responding to requests for consultation from Tribal Nations.

In response to the letter FEMA received from the Inter-Tribal Emergency Management Coalition (ITEMC) Chairman, we invite you to attend an in-person tribal consultation on August 22, 2024, during the ITEMC Summit to discuss FEMA grant programs. The purpose of the tribal consultation is to gather feedback on how FEMA can support increasing Tribal Nation access to its grant programs.

The tribal consultation will be hosted by FEMA leadership. Topics include:

- FEMA grant program processes and applications;
- Tribal barriers and challenges, including the accessibility of FEMA grants; and
- Other tribal needs related to grant programs at FEMA.

The tribal consultation will be in-person.
