Beyond the Basics is the product of a 5-year research study conducted by the Coastal Hazards Center and the Center for Sustainable Community Design at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC). As part of this study, researchers at UNC systematically analyzed 175 local hazard mitigation plans drawn from six states (CA, GA, LA, NC, TX and WA) to assess their content and quality. Each plan was evaluated using a hazard mitigation plan quality protocol that has been developed, tested and applied over several projects across the country. This website features numerous examples and best practices that were drawn from high quality hazard mitigation plans identified as part of the UNC study.
