Workshop Goal

To provide plan developers with the information necessary to prepare and implement a Tribal hazard mitigation plan.



Workshop Objectives

Remember! Even after your Tribal plan is approved, the planning process continues through implementation of your mitigation strategy. In addition, your plan must be updated every five years to maintain eligibility for certain FEMA grants.



Planning Process

- Hazard Mitigation and Mitigation Planning
- Building the Tribal Planning Team
- Engage the Public
- Integrate the Planning Process



Risk Assessment

- Describe your community and its assets
- Identify the hazards that affect your community
- Assess the vulnerability and develop problem statements



Mitigation Strategy

- Look at your existing capabilities to implement mitigation projects
- Use the problem statements to identify how to prevent losses
- Prioritize your needs with the action plan



Plan Maintenance

- The plan is meant to be a living document!
- Integrate the plan into other existing plans and capabilities
- Keep the public involved throughout the process



Plan Implementation

- Adopt the plan
- Put the plan into action
- Identify challenges and solutions
- Move mitigation forward
- Mitigation funding and assistance
