

Lee County Recovery at a Glance

Since the federal disaster declaration for Hurricane Ian, Lee County residents have received more than **\$997.1** million in federal funds as of Dec. 12, 2022:

- **\$337.9 million** in FEMA grants to homeowners and renters.
- **\$659.2 million** in U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) low-interest disaster loans approved for homeowners, renters and businesses.

Individual Assistance in Lee County:

- **191,720** homeowners and renters have been approved for **\$337,917,362** in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program. This includes:
 - **\$247,900,424** in Housing Assistance grants for home repair, home replacement, and/or rental assistance.
 - **\$90,016,938** in Other Needs Assistance grants to replace essential household items and for other critical disaster-related expenses.
- **18,686** homeowners and renters have been approved for rental assistance.
- **Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA)** visited **117,900** households in Lee County.

U.S. Small Business Administration:

- SBA has approved **\$659,280,677** in low-interest disaster loans to **7.849** applicants in Lee County.
